# **About MDPI**

MDPI is a publisher of fully peer-reviewed, open access journals with a focus on robust and rapid editorial processes.

In the MDPI Annual Achievements Report 2024, released in March 2025, we reflect on a year of growth, collaboration, and continued commitment to open access publishing. This report highlights our achievements and the impact we made in 2024—driven by our focus on delivering an efficient, high-quality publishing experience.

Our global expansion, marked by a growing workforce and a new office in South Korea, strengthened our presence in key research regions. With over 238,000 peer-reviewed articles published and 25 million downloads of our open-access research, MDPI continues to advance scientific communication on a global scale.

### **Global Impact**

MDPI published 238,000 peer-reviewed open-access articles, with over 25 million article downloads worldwide.

### **Employee Growth**

MDPI's workforce increased to 6,650 employees worldwide, adding 750+ new staff members.

### **Peer Review**

Over 215,000 reviewers ensured reliable peer review, with a 60% manuscript rejection rate.

### **Submissions**

The number of articles submitted by researchers from the Asia-Pacific region increased by 15–20% compared to 2023.

### Reach

More than 150 million website visits and more than 25 million article downloads by 60 million users.

### Relevance

60 MDPI journals newly indexed in Web of Science, bringing our total to 297 (end of 2024), and 37 journals newly indexed in Scopus, bringing the total to 306.


